

Alpaca and Kid Silk Haze scarf



25 gram Kid Silk Haze (or any other really thin mohair yarn)
100 gram thin Alpaca.
Circular needles number 6
Crochet hook nr 3.5
1 safety pin.

Always knit with 1 strand thin alpaca and 1 strand of thin mohair.

Cast on 150 stitches on 6 mm circular needles,
Work 2 rows in garter stitch.

Work pattern like this:

1 Row: k2, *yo, k2tog* until 2 stitches remain, k2.
2 Row: Garter stitch.
3. Row: Garter stitch.

When you have knitted the scarf about 20 cm wide, loosely cast off all stitches.

Flower:

With 2 strands of alpaca and crochet hook 3.5 chain 4.

1. 14 dc in fourth ch from hook. Join with a sl st in top of ch-4.
2. Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3 skip next 2 sts *sc in next st, ch 3, skip next 2 sts* join with sl st in first sc.
3. ch 1 * sc, hdc, 5 dc, hdc, sc* in next ch. Repeat from * to * around. Join with hdc in first sc. Fasten off.
4. With 2 strands of thin mohair, crochet 2 sc in every st. join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Sew the safety pin on to the back of the flower.
